Good Morning,

It's been a busy start of the year for UGE. Earlier today, we [announced](#) the completion of two large solar portfolios, adding another 10 MW to Canada's installed solar PV capacity.

One portfolio, with a total installed capacity of 3.7 MW, included 17 rooftop solar projects at Ontario school properties. The other portfolio, with a total installed capacity of 6.3 MW, included 11 ground-mount solar projects.

In addition, UGE introduced its Vision 2020 to investors at the recent MicroCap Conference in New York, laying out our clear plan towards \$100m in annual revenue and \$10m in EBITDA. We discussed aspects of this plan on recent appearances on [BNN](#) and [CBC](#). I also shared my perspective in a recent print edition of [Barron's](#).

### First Quarter Financial Results

UGE will be releasing its first quarter financial results on May 15, 2018 before market open.
